ITINERARY

DAY 1 – MAY 23

Your journey begins with motorcoach transportation from Buffalo, Rochester, or Syracuse, accompanied by a AAA Group Travel Tour Host. Travel to the scenic shores of Cape Cod, where you'll check in to your resort and meet your local guide. DAY 3 – MAY 25

Today, ferry to the picturesque island of Nantucket, known for its cobblestone streets, historic charm, and seaside beauty. Enjoy a guided island tour followed by admission to the renowned Nantucket Whaling Museum, home to fascinating artifacts and a massive whale skeleton.

Begin your day with a guided tour of Hyannis, including the John F. Kennedy Memorial and other notable landmarks tied to the Kennedy family. Kennedy Hyannis Museum to learn more about the region's seafaring heritage and presidential history. Enjoy free time along Main Street before an included dinner this evening.
