ITINERARY:

Day 1 - September 26

Travel by motorcoach from Buffalo, Rochester, or Syracuse, arrive in Danbury, CT and enjoy a visit to the Danbury Railway Museum, housed in the historic 1903 Union Station. Explore railroad artifacts, model train layouts, and a 10-acre rail yard featuring vintage railcars, including pieces from the famed 20th Century Limited. Enjoy a short narrated train ride through the yard and a unique ride on the working turntable used to rotate locomotives. This evening, check in to your hotel and enjoy a welcome dinner at a local restaurant.

Day 2 - September 27, 2026

After breakfast, depart Danbury for a memorable Essex Steam Train & Connecticut Riverboat Cruise experience. Travel by vintage steam train through scenic New England towns before boarding the Becky Thatcher riverboat for a narrated cruise showcasing wildlife, wetlands, and historic river landmarks. A boxed lunch is included during the cruise. Continue to Cape Cod for a visit to the Whydah Pirate Museum, home to the world's only authenticated pirate treasure recovered from a 1717 shipwreck. Check in to your Cape Cod hotel and enjoy a classic New England lobster dinner.

Day 3 - September 28

Following breakfast, meet your local guide for a full day exploring Cape Cod along historic Route 6A, the Old King's Highway, passing windmills, colonial homes, lighthouses, and Cape Cod National Seashore highlights. Continue to Provincetown at the tip of the Cape, where the Pilgrims first landed in 1620 and signed the Mayflower Compact. Lunch is on your own before choosing between a Whale Watch Cruise led by onboard naturalists or a guided Dune Tour through protected National Seashore lands. Enjoy dinner at a local restaurant before returning to your hotel.

Day 4 - September 29

After breakfast, travel with your guide to historic Plymouth, America's Hometown. Enjoy photo stops at Plymouth Rock, the Forefathers Monument, and views of the restored Mayflower II, followed by a narrated Plymouth Harbor Cruise aboard the Pilgrim Belle paddlewheel boat. After free time for lunch on the waterfront, continue to Boston for leisure time at Quincy Market and Faneuil Hall, a lively hub of shops, history, and dining. Dinner is included this evening before checking in to your Boston-area hotel.



Group Travel

Day 5 - September 30

This morning, after breakfast, board the Amtrak Downeaster Train for a scenic rail journey to Maine. Upon arrival, meet your local guide for a narrated coastal tour of Kennebunk and Kennebunkport, including views of beaches, rocky shorelines, and the Bush family estate at Walker's Point. Enjoy lunch on your own in charming Dock Square, followed by a visit to the Seashore Trolley Museum, featuring a ride on a restored historic streetcar. Check in to your hotel and enjoy a traditional Maine lobster dinner.

Day 6 - October 1

Following breakfast, travel to New Hampshire for the Fall Foliage Special Train, offering breathtaking views of lakes, rivers, and autumn landscapes. Ride north to Plymouth, NH, where a hot luncheon is served at the Common Man Inn before touring the restored Ashland Railroad Station with local historians. Each guest receives a commemorative souvenir booklet filled with history and photos. Return to Meredith mid-afternoon and continue to your resort-style hotel for dinner and overnight.

Day 7 - October 2

After breakfast, meet your guide for a full day in New Hampshire's Lakes Region, beginning with a cruise aboard the M/S Mount Washington on Lake Winnipesaukee, including a stop in Wolfeboro, America's oldest summer resort. Continue to Hermit Woods Winery for a guided tour and wine tasting paired with charcuterie, serving as a light lunch. If time permits, browse the shops and waterfront walkways at Mill Falls Marketplace. This afternoon, board the Winnipesaukee Scenic Railroad Turkey Dinner Train for a two-hour journey featuring a freshly carved turkey meal served at your table.

Day 8 - October 3

Following breakfast, depart New Hampshire for the scenic Berkshires of Massachusetts. Enjoy a guided mansion tour and traditional Victorian Tea at historic Ventfort Hall in Lenox, offering a glimpse into Gilded Age elegance (tea serves as a light lunch). This afternoon, visit the Norman Rockwell Museum, home to the largest collection of the artist's original works set on a beautiful 36-acre campus. Dinner is included this evening before checking in to your Berkshire hotel.

Day 9 - October 4

Enjoy breakfast at your hotel before departing for home, concluding your memorable New England rail, coastal, and foliage adventure.
