Explore the charm, history, and flavors of Northern Virginia on this engaging countryside getaway. Step back in time with guided visits to Oatlands Historic House & Gardens, George C. Marshall's Dodona Manor, and a guided driving tour of the Manassas Battlefield, complemented by a self-guided visit to the historic Ben Lomond site. Savor the region's renowned craft beverages with tastings at Blue Valley Vineyard & Winery, The Winery at Bull Run—featuring stories of its Civil War connections—Sunshine Ridge Farm, Old Farm Winery at Hartland, Zephaniah Farm Vineyard, and a visit to Wyndridge Farm for a flight of handcrafted beer or cider. Blending heritage, scenic landscapes, and local hospitality, this tour offers a memorable taste of Virginia's past and present.

ITINERARY

DAY 1

Travel by motorcoach from Buffalo, Rochester, or Syracuse to Pennsylvania and Virginia, settling in as scenic autumn landscapes unfold along the way. This afternoon, arrive at Wyndridge Farm, where you'll relax on the covered patio and courtyard while enjoying panoramic fall foliage views. An included flight of handcrafted beer or cider introduces the flavors of the region, followed by an early included dinner accompanied by live music entertainment. Continue to Chantilly, Virginia, where you'll check in for your overnight stay at the Westfields Marriott Washington Dulles, and enjoy a restful evening at the hotel. (D)

DAY 2

After enjoying an included breakfast at the hotel, depart for Oatlands Historic House & Gardens, a beautifully preserved 418-acre estate where a guided tour brings to life centuries of history through formal gardens, historic outbuildings, and the elegant mansion itself. Continue to Hunter's Head Tavern for an included lunch at this farm-owned gastropub, celebrated for its sustainable cuisine and cozy hunt-country charm. The afternoon features a visit to Blue Valley Vineyard and Winery, where a guided tour and tasting are paired with breathtaking views of the Blue Ridge Mountains. Later, arrive at The Winery at Bull Run for a history tour and wine tasting set on storied Civil War grounds, followed by an included dinner in the winery's Barrel Room. Return to the hotel for the evening. (B, L, D)

DAY 3

Begin the day with an included breakfast before departing for a guided driving tour of the Manassas Battlefield, where expert interpretation reveals the significance of this pivotal Civil War site. Continue to the Ben Lomond Historic Site for a guided experience featuring the antebellum home, hands-on Civil War-era activities, a musket firing demonstration, and traditional s'mores treat. Midday brings a visit to The Winery at Sunshine Ridge Farm, where an included boxed lunch is paired with a wine tasting held in the upstairs art gallery overlooking the water. This afternoon, travel to Old Farm Winery at Hartland for a guided tasting complemented by light charcuterie snacks in a charming farm setting. The day concludes with an included dinner at Magnolias at the Mill, offering New American cuisine in a beautifully restored country mill, before returning to the hotel. (B, L, D)

DAY 4

Enjoy an included breakfast at the hotel before checking out. This morning, visit George C. Marshall's Dodona Manor for a guided tour of the former home of the statesman behind the Marshall Plan, set within Leesburg's historic district. Guests rotate through the home tour and a historical lecture, complemented by coffee and beignets. Continue to Zephaniah Farm Vineyard for a winery tour and tasting, accompanied by the "A Little Bit of Loudoun" specialty food sampler featuring selections from beloved local restaurants. Following this final tasting experience, travel by motorcoach as you return home with memories of Virginia's rich history, rolling countryside, exceptional wines, and unforgettable fall scenery.
