# ITINERARY

## DAY 1

Begin your journey with early morning departures from Syracuse, Rochester, or Buffalo, with brief rest and meal stops along the way. Upon arrival in Toledo, check in for a one-night stay with baggage handling included. In the evening, enjoy a delicious dinner with your fellow travelers.

## DAY 2

Start your day with breakfast before boarding the motorcoach for the journey to Mackinac Island, with a lunch stop along the way. Upon arrival at Shepler's Ferry Terminal in Mackinaw City and board the ferry for a scenic ride to the island, where motorized vehicles are replaced by bicycles, horses, and walking paths. After a short walk to The Lake View Hotel, check in for your three-night stay. Upon check-in, you'll receive a \$50 gift card for meals or activities and an attraction ticket valid at several historic sites and museums on the island. Enjoy dinner and the evening at your leisure.

## DAY 3

Start your day with breakfast at your leisure, using your included gift card if you wish. This morning, embark on a narrated horse-drawn carriage tour of Mackinac Island, concluding at the historic Grand Hotel. Enjoy time browsing the hotel's museum and gift shop before gathering with your fellow travelers for the legendary Grand Luncheon Buffet.
