ITINERARY

DAY 1

Depart by motorcoach from Buffalo, Rochester, or Syracuse with your AAA Group Travel Tour Host to New York City's JFK Airport for your overnight flight to Italy.

DAY 2

Arrive in Naples and meet your local tour guide and transfer to your hotel on the Amalfi Coast. Enjoy the rest of the day at leisure before a welcome cocktail, orientation, and group dinner.

DAY 3

Full-day guided tour along the Amalfi Coast. Visit Ravello for its stunning views, then continue to Amalfi to explore its historic center and the Cathedral of Saint Andrew. Dinner is at a local restaurant.

DAY 4

Enjoy a traditional limoncello tasting and discover local production techniques. Explore the village of Minori with time for shopping and leisure. In the evening, participate in a hands-on pasta-making class with a master chef, followed by dinner.

DAY 5

This morning, explore the ancient ruins of Pompeii with a guided tour of its main streets, homes, and monuments. This afternoon, visit a local ceramics workshop to learn about the traditional craftsmanship, followed by a pizza-making demonstration and tasting.

DAY 6

The Amalfi Coast is famous for their colorful pottery/ceramics. Today you will have the opportunity to visit one of the local factories and see the fine art ceramics. Late night pizza making demonstration and tasting.

DAY 7

Travel by hydrofoil to the island of Capri. Ride the funicular to the town center for a guided walking tour and free time to explore. Enjoy views of the Faraglioni rocks before returning to the mainland for dinner and a limoncello tasting.

DAY 8

Visit Sorrento, known for its artisan shops, lemon groves, and lively piazzas. Continue to scenic viewpoints overlooking Positano for breathtaking coastal views.

DAY 9

Enjoy a relaxing day at leisure to explore or unwind. In the evening, gather for a festive farewell dinner with music, entertainment, and a tasting of local specialties including traditional desserts.

DAY 10

Transfer to Naples Airport for your return flight home, bringing your Amalfi Coast journey to a close.
