## ITINERARY

### DAY 1 – SEPTEMBER 4

Travel with your AAA Group Travel Tour Host by motorcoach from Buffalo, Rochester, or Syracuse to Toronto Pearson International Airport for your overnight flight to Scotland.

### DAY 2 – SEPTEMBER 5

Arrive in Edinburgh and transfer to your hotel located in the vibrant West End of Glasgow near the Botanic Gardens. This afternoon, enjoy a panoramic city tour showcasing Glasgow's Victorian and Art Nouveau architecture, rich maritime heritage, and dynamic cultural scene. Conclude the day with a welcome drink and dinner at your hotel.
