DAY 1 – MONDAY, MAY 17, 2027

Depart from Buffalo, Rochester, or Syracuse with your AAA Group Travel Tour Host for transfer to Toronto Pearson International Airport. Upon arrival, check-in for your overnight flight to Geneva, Switzerland. Relax and prepare for an unforgettable luxury journey through the breathtaking Swiss Alps.

DAY 2 – TUESDAY, MAY 18, 2027

Welcome to Geneva, Switzerland's elegant "City of Gardens." Upon arrival at Geneva Airport, meet your Local Travel Director and transfer to your hotel.
