ACTIVITY LEVEL ACTIVE

Moderate pace; good mobility needed. Expect a variety of walking experiences, including time spent exploring attractions on foot, navigating stairs, standing during guided activities, and walking on varied terrain or uneven surfaces. Travelers should be comfortable with longer touring days that may include extended periods of activity, limited opportunities to sit, and maintaining a steady pace throughout the itinerary. This activity level is not recommended for travelers with mobility challenges that require the use of a cane, walker, or wheelchair, as the pace of the tour and physical demands may make it difficult to keep up with the group, navigate certain environments comfortably, or fully participate in included activities.
