ITINERARY:

DAY 1 - Depart from Buffalo, Rochester, or Syracuse as you begin your coastal adventure. Upon arrival in Dover, Delaware, check into the Fairfield by Marriott Inn & Suites (for two nights), where baggage handling is included. This evening, enjoy a delicious dinner buffet at McGlynns Pub, a local favorite known for its relaxed atmosphere and hearty fare. (D)

DAY 2 - After breakfast, explore Delaware's rich history with a guided tour of Belmont Hall, an elegant 1773 Georgian mansion surrounded by beautiful gardens, followed by a visit to the Smyrna Museum, housed in two 18th-century buildings that reveal the town's early heritage. Enjoy free time for lunch and seaside strolling along the lively Rehoboth Beach Boardwalk, a beloved East Coast beach destination. Continue to Historic Lewes, the "First Town in the First State," for a guided tour including the Lewes History Museum and tales of the town's maritime and colonial past. End the day with dinner at Crooked Hammock Brewery, where you'll dine and unwind in a laid-back, backyard-style setting. (B, D)

DAY 3 - Start the day with breakfast before boarding the Cape May-Lewes Ferry, a scenic cruise across Delaware Bay offering views of historic lighthouses and local wildlife. Arrive in charming Cape May, New Jersey, known for its Victorian architecture and seaside ambiance. Enjoy lunch on your own and free time to explore the shops and restaurants of Washington Street Mall before visiting the beautifully preserved Emlen Physick Estate, an 1879 Victorian mansion museum. Then, board a narrated trolley tour through Cape May's historic district, featuring grand Victorian homes and landmarks. This evening, check into the elegant La Mer Beachfront Resort, then cap the day with a Sunset Dinner Cruise aboard the Spirit of Cape May—featuring a full meal, breathtaking coastal views, and the chance to spot dolphins at play. (B, D)

DAY 4 - After breakfast, enjoy a guided tour through Cape May Point, one of North America's premier bird migration sites. Visit the fully restored Cape May Lighthouse (built in 1859) and stop at Sunset Beach to see the remains of the historic concrete ship Atlantis, and search for glistening "Cape May Diamonds," the area's famous naturally polished quartz pebbles. Then, sit back and relax as you journey home with wonderful memories of your coastal getaway. (B)
