ITINERARY:

Day 1

Day 2

After breakfast, set sail on a scenic Tall Ships Cruise of Boston Harbor. Enjoy expert narration from your captain as you take in the harbor views and learn about Boston's maritime heritage.

Following the cruise, spend time exploring the Tall Ships on your own before heading to the Boston Tea Party Ships & Museum. A costumed colonial guide will lead you through interactive exhibits, full-scale ship replicas, and a lively re-enactment of the Tea Party—where you'll even have a chance to toss tea into the harbor!

This evening, head to Quincy Market for dinner on your own. Stroll the cobblestone paths, enjoy street performers, and sample a variety of foods. With over 100 shops and stalls, there's something for everyone. Be sure to visit the nearby Faneuil Hall, a historic marketplace and meeting site since 1742.

Day 3

Enjoy breakfast before meeting your local guide for a memorable day of discovery. This morning, set out on the New England Aquarium Whale Watch Cruise to Stellwagen Bank Marine Sanctuary—home to humpback, finback, and minke whales. Onboard naturalists will share fascinating insights as you witness these incredible creatures in their natural habitat.

After the cruise, enjoy free time exploring nearby attractions on your own, such as the New England Aquarium, Boston Science Center, or simply stroll along the waterfront.

This evening, gather with your group for a delicious dinner at a local restaurant to reflect on the day's adventures.



Day 4

Enjoy breakfast before heading to the Charlestown Navy Yard, home to the historic USS Constitution, the world's oldest commissioned warship still afloat. Board "Old Ironsides" for a self-guided tour, with Navy crew members available to answer questions. Note: A valid REAL ID compliant or Enhanced photo ID or passport is required for entry.

Explore the USS Constitution Museum, packed with interactive exhibits and artifacts, and visit the Visitor Center for memorabilia and gifts. You'll also have time to tour the USS Cassin Young, a WWII Navy destroyer.

Enjoy an included lunch at Waverly Kitchen before boarding the motorcoach for your journey home, filled with memories of Boston's rich maritime and revolutionary history.
