## **ITINERARY:**

## Day 1 - May 29

Depart Western and Central New York overnight for Paris, France.

## Day 2 - May 30

Bienvenue! The 'City of Light' welcomes you as you prepare to embark on an unforgettable journey through France. Join your Travel Director this afternoon for an orientation drive to admire the glittering cityscape of Paris – past grand boulevards and iconic sites like the Champs-Élysées and the Arc de Triomphe and get to know your traveling companions over dinner this evening. Dinner is included today. Evergreen Laurel Hotel Paris (1 night).

## Day 3 - May 31

Leave Paris behind and travel to Rouen, the city where Joan of Arc was burnt at the stake. From here, you'll continue to Honfleur, a harbor town known for its colorful shopfronts and artistic heritage. Take time to explore its streets and soak up the views that have inspired painters for centuries. Changing pace, visit Distillerie Busnel, one of Normandy's oldest working distilleries. Walk through the distillery, learn about the time-honored craft of Calvados production, and round off the experience with a tasting that captures the flavors of the region. Breakfast and Dinner are included today. Hôtel Mercure Omaha Beach (2 nights).

# <u>Day 4 – June 1</u>

Today, explore the poignant D-Day Landing Beaches in the company of your Local Specialist. Begin with a visit to the American Rangers Memorial at Pointe du Hoc. Pay tribute to the brave souls who lost their lives at Omaha Beach, imagining the mingled sense of terror and triumph felt on the fateful day when Allied forces set foot on mainland Europe. Stop for lunch (on own) in the seaside town of Arromanches, the setting for Mulberry Harbor, once at the heart of the Normandy landings. Breakfast is included today.

# **Day 5 – June 2**

Travel through the Normandy countryside admiring the land of calvados before exploring the UNESCO World Heritage site, Bay of the Mont-Saint-Michel. Your Local Specialist reveals the history of the impressive medieval Benedictine Abbey perched on the hilltop. In Brittany enjoy the afternoon your way or, perhaps discover the beauty of the port city of St. Malo with a Local



Specialist on the Jewels of St. Malo Optional Experience. Breakfast and Dinner are included today. Hotel de l'Abbaye Le Tronchet (1 night).

## **Day 6 – June 3**

Journey onward through scenic countryside, stopping to connect with locals at lunch with wine in a 17th-century château during an experience set within beautiful grounds. Later, continue to the beautiful Loire Valley, where you will spend the next two nights. Breakfast and Lunch are included today. Novotel Amboise (2 nights).

## **Day 7 - June 4**

In the morning, taste hand-crafted chocolate at Maison Bigot. Afterwards, spend your day admiring the beautiful châteaux of the Loire Valley and join a Local Specialist for a visit to the Amboise Royal Château. It is here that King François I hosted Leonardo da Vinci, whose tomb now lies in the Chapel of Saint-Hubert adjoining the château. Continue with a visit to Château de Chenonceau, built on the Cher River. The château is often referred to as the 'Ladies Castle', due to the many women who influenced its construction and development. Today it contains priceless collections, including Renaissance furniture, tapestries and masterpieces by Rubens and Tintoretto. Breakfast is included today.

# Day 8 - June 5

Following breakfast, your first stop today is the town of Chartres and its beautiful Roman Catholic cathedral, regarded as one of the most authentic and complete works of religious architecture from the early 13th century. Journey back to Paris this afternoon and spend the rest of your day in the 'City of Light'. Celebrate with your Travel Director and fellow travelers this evening at a Farewell Dinner with local wines at a Parisian bistro. Breakfast and Dinner are included today. Renaissance Paris La Défense (1 night).

# Day 9 – June 6

Farewell France. Following breakfast, you'll transfer to the Paris airport for your return flight to Western and Central New York. Breakfast is included today.
