ITINERARY:



Day 1 – Welcome to Utah Depart from Buffalo, Rochester, or Syracuse and fly to Salt Lake City, where majestic mountain views and western charm await. Check in for two nights at the luxurious **Grand America Hotel**, an elegant downtown retreat. This evening, gather with your fellow travelers for a festive welcome dinner and get acquainted over a delicious meal. (D)

Day 2 – Discover Salt Lake City Begin your day with a guided tour of Salt Lake City, uncovering highlights such as Temple Square, the State Capitol, and more. The afternoon is yours to explore at leisure—stroll downtown, visit local shops and museums, or relax at your beautiful hotel. (B)

Day 3 – Salt Lake City to Moab by Rail Board the Rocky Mountaineer from Salt Lake City to the red rock landscapes of Moab. As the train winds through the Wasatch Mountains, take in sights like the historic Thistle Tunnel, the dramatic Castle Gate, and the scenic beauty of Price Canyon. Arrive in Thompson Springs before continuing to Moab, where you'll spend the night in a **centrally located hotel**. Enjoy time to explore this vibrant desert town or unwind for the evening. Day 4 – Moab to Glenwood Springs by Rail Enjoy a leisurely morning in Moab—perhaps visit a local café or take in desert views. In the afternoon, reboard the Rocky Mountaineer for a stunning ride from Moab to Glenwood Springs. Highlights include the dramatic cliffs of Ruby Canyon, the colorful layers of Debeque Canyon, and scenic views as you cross into Colorado. Settle into your charming **hotel in the heart of Glenwood Springs** and enjoy a relaxed evening. (B, L and D)

Day 5 – Glenwood Springs to Denver by Rail Continue your rail adventure eastward aboard the Canyon Spirit train. Marvel at a series of awe-inspiring canyons—Glenwood, Byers, and Gore—as well as engineering marvels like the Moffat Tunnel. Cross the Continental Divide before arriving in Denver, Colorado's vibrant capital city. Spend the evening exploring the downtown area or relaxing at **Hotel Indigo**, your stylish home for the next two nights. (B and L)

Day 6 – Explore the Rockies Set out on a scenic tour of Denver's surrounding wonders. Highlights include the world-famous Red Rocks Park & Amphitheatre, the rugged beauty of Clear Creek Canyon, the charming town of Idaho Springs, serene Echo Lake, and panoramic views from Squaw Pass. Return to Denver with time to enjoy dinner or explore the city at your own pace. (B)
