ITINERARY:

Day 1: Depart from Syracuse, Rochester, or Buffalo and travel via motorcoach with your AAA Group Travel Tour Host and fellow travelers to Toronto airport for your non-stop overnight flight to Rome.

Day 2: Ciao Roma! Arrive in the legendary “Eternal City,” once home to gods, emperors, and gladiators. After checking in at the Crowne Plaza St. Peter’s for two nights, meet your fellow travelers and Travel Director over a delicious, included dinner. This evening, enjoy an orientation drive through Rome, taking in illuminated views of some of its most celebrated landmarks as your guide shares stories that bring the city’s rich history to life. Day 3: After breakfast, join a Local Specialist for a fascinating sightseeing tour. Cross the Tiber River into Ancient Rome to view the imposing Colosseum and learn about the empire that once ruled the known world. Stroll through piazzas, admire ornate architecture, and soak in the vibrant atmosphere as you experience both ancient wonders and modern Roman charm. (B)

Day 4: Travel north through the picturesque vineyard-clad hills of Tuscany to a stunning 12th-century castle where the infamous Pazzi plot against the Medici family began. Enjoy an exclusive lunch hosted by the castle’s caretakers, complete with a guided tour and a peek inside its dungeons, your visit directly helps preserve this historic treasure. Continue to Florence for a demonstration of traditional Florentine leathercraft, then join a Local Specialist for a walking tour to admire masterpieces like the marble Duomo and the lively Piazza della Signoria. This afternoon check into the Grand Mediterraneo hotel for one night. (B, L)

Day 5: Arrive in the romantic floating city of Venice and cruise its shimmering canals for views of St. Mark’s Basilica and the ornate Doge’s Palace. Witness the centuries-old art of Venetian glassblowing, watching master craftsmen transform molten glass into delicate works of art. Spend the afternoon exploring at leisure—wander charming alleyways, relax in St. Mark’s Square, or sip a Venetian Spritz while the sun sets over the Grand Canal. This afternoon check into the Novotel Mestre Castellana for one night. (B)

Day 6: Depart Venice and travel through the scenic Italian and Swiss Lake Districts, passing Como and Lugano before crossing the majestic Alps. Arrive in Lucerne, a lakeside gem known for its medieval Chapel Bridge and moving Lion Monument. Enjoy time at leisure to stroll the charming Old Town or join an optional mountain excursion for breathtaking panoramic views. This evening, savor an included dinner at your hotel, the Grand Europe – your home for one night. (B, D)

Day 7: Journey from Switzerland into France, traveling through Burgundy’s rolling vineyards, renowned for producing some of the world’s finest wines. Arrive in Paris and spend your evening as you wish—perhaps dining at a traditional bistro, strolling along the Seine, or joining an optional evening cruise to see the “City of Light” sparkle at night. This afternoon check into the Oceania Porte de Versailles hotel for two nights. (B)

Day 8: The morning is yours to enjoy at leisure, or you may choose an optional excursion to the magnificent Palace of Versailles. Later, join a Local Specialist for a sightseeing tour of Paris, including the elegant Champs-Élysées, Arc de Triomphe, and the iconic Eiffel Tower. View Notre Dame Cathedral and wander through the charming Latin Quarter before enjoying free time to shop, explore museums, or simply savor the Parisian atmosphere. (B)

Day 9: Au Revoir Paris! After a final breakfast, bid farewell to your fellow travelers as your unforgettable European journey comes to an end and you return to Western and Central New York. (B)
