Sunday, May 3, 2026

Early morning boarding begins at AAA Travel & Insurance Center, 100 International Dr, Williamsville, NY.

Early morning boarding begins at RIT Inn & Conference Center, 5257 W Henrietta Rd, Henrietta, NY. A brief rest stop will be made.

Monday, May 4, 2026

Arrive at **Monticello**, home of Thomas Jefferson. Explore the meticulously preserved historic home, stroll through the beautifully maintained gardens, and visit **Mulberry Row**, the bustling industrial hub of Jefferson's estate. **The Visitor Center** offers engaging educational exhibits that deepen your understanding of Jefferson's life and times.

Enjoy an included **lunch** at Historic Michie Tavern. This is one of the oldest homesteads remaining in Virginia. The Tavern offers a glimpse of 18th-century life through the exhibit of handcrafted furnishings and artifacts.

Visit **James Monroe's Highland** and meet "Mr. Monroe." Adjacent to Thomas Jefferson's Monticello was the estate of James Monroe, a Founding Father and fifth president of the United States.

Enjoy dinner on your own and free time downtown Charlottesville Pedestrian Mall, filled with shops, cafes, and galleries.

Tuesday, May 5, 2026

Enjoy an included hotel **breakfast** at your leisure before check-out.

Meet your **Local Guide** and visit **The Rotunda & Academical Village** of The University of Virginia with a Guided Tour. The Rotunda was designed by Thomas Jefferson to represent the "authority of nature and power of reason" and was inspired by the Pantheon in Rome.

Visit James Madison's Montpelier, the elegant plantation home of the "Father of the Constitution."

Enjoy an included **boxed lunch** while on your way to Alexandria, VA.

Visit **Mount Vernon and the Ford Orientation Center & Donald W. Reynolds Museum and Education Center.** Explore the grand mansion, extensive museum, beautifully landscaped gardens, and surrounding grounds that reveal the life of the nation's first president.

Enjoy included **dinner** at The Mount Vernon Inn Restaurant, known for its colonial-inspired dishes and historic ambiance.

Check-in for your **one-night stay** at the Hampton Inn & Suites Fort Belvoir Alexandria South in Alexandria. **Baggage handling** included.

Arrive to **tour Fredericksburg with a Local Guide**. Discover **Historic Kenmore**, the elegant 18th-century home of George Washington's sister, the **Mary Washington House**, where his mother lived, and the **Rising Sun Tavern**, a beloved colonial inn and social hub.

Enjoy included **dinner** at The Whaling Company in Williamsburg, VA., a local favorite offering fresh seafood and coastal flavors.

Check-in for your **two-night stay** at the Embassy Suites by Hilton in Williamsburg, VA. **Baggage handling** is included.

Thursday, May 7, 2026

Enjoy an included hotel **breakfast** at your leisure.

Arrive for a **guided tour of Colonial Williamsburg**, the largest outdoor living museum in the country, offering immersive, authentic 18th-century experiences and programming.

Enjoy lunch on your own in Merchant Square, a bustling area of shops and eateries that blend historic charm with modern amenities.

Take a **guided tour of Yorktown Victory Center**, where immersive exhibits and live demonstrations recount the dramatic conclusion of the American Revolutionary War.
