ITINERARY:

Day 1: After a comfortable journey from Buffalo, Rochester, or Syracuse, you'll arrive at the Crowne Plaza Dulles Airport in the early evening and check in with baggage handling included. Meet your guide and enjoy a delicious welcome dinner at Ristorante Bonaroti, an elegant Italian restaurant known for its handmade pastas and old-world ambiance. After dinner, return to the hotel to rest and prepare for the adventures ahead. (D)

Day 2: Start your day with breakfast at the hotel before heading into Washington, DC for the National Cherry Blossom Parade. You'll enjoy premium grandstand seating near the National Archives with a great view of the vibrant performances and celebrity appearances—don't forget to wave your pink pom-poms for the cameras! After the parade, enjoy time on your own to grab a light snack and explore the National Portrait Gallery and Penn Quarter. In the afternoon, board the elegant Odyssey III for a festive Cherry Blossom Cruise on the Potomac, featuring a signature pink drink, live music, dancing, and a delicious late lunch. Be sure to wear pink for a chance to win a prize! Following the cruise, enjoy a scenic stroll along the Tidal Basin to see the cherry trees in blossom and visit several iconic memorials, including those honoring Dr. Martin Luther King Jr., Franklin D. Roosevelt, and Thomas Jefferson. End the day with a relaxing dinner at a classic Irish pub before returning to the hotel for the night. (B, L, D)

Day 3: Begin your day with breakfast at the hotel before visiting Arlington National Cemetery, one of the nation's most sacred sites. Ride the tram through the grounds and witness the powerful Changing of the Guard at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier. Next, enjoy scenic drives along Embassy Row and past the Washington National Cathedral, followed by a delightful lunch and visit at the elegant Hillwood Estate, Museum and Gardens—home to stunning art collections and beautifully manicured grounds. In the afternoon, tour several of Washington, DC's most moving monuments, including the Vietnam Veterans, Lincoln, and Korean War Memorials. The day concludes with a seafood dinner at Tony & Joe's overlooking the river, and evening stops at the Kennedy Center and Marine Corps Memorial before returning to the hotel for the night. Day 4: Begin your day with breakfast at the hotel before visiting two powerful memorials: the soaring spires of the Air Force Memorial and the reflective World War II Memorial honoring the Greatest Generation. Then, enjoy time to explore the Smithsonian Museums at your own pace. With a wide range of options—from the National Museum of American History to the Air & Space Museum—there’s something for every interest. Lunch is on your own while exploring the National Mall. In the afternoon, dive into American history at *The People’s House: A White House Experience*, an engaging and modern exhibit dedicated to the legacy of the Executive Mansion and its residents. End the day with dinner at The Point, a scenic waterfront restaurant, followed by a beautiful, illuminated driving tour of Washington’s iconic monuments. (B, D)

Day 5: On your final day, enjoy breakfast at the hotel and check out with baggage handling included. Then head to Capitol Hill for a guided tour of the iconic U.S. Capitol, where you’ll explore historic halls, art-filled corridors, and learn about the heart of American democracy. Afterward, enjoy lunch on your own at the Capitol Visitor Center before beginning the journey home, filled with memories of your time in the nation’s capital. (B)
