ITINERARY:

Day 1: Your journey begins with departures from Buffalo, Rochester, or Syracuse as you head for the picturesque shores of Cape Cod. Upon arrival, you'll settle into the Holiday Inn Hyannis, your home base for the week. Take in the charm of this beloved seaside destination known for its quaint villages, scenic coastline, and coastal nostalgia. Tonight, enjoy a relaxing included dinner and get to know your fellow travelers as your Cape Cod adventure begins. (D)

Day 2: Start the day with breakfast at the hotel, then embark on a scenic drive along historic Route 6A, known as the Old King's Highway. You'll visit a local windmill, a Cape Cod lighthouse, and the Cape Cod National Seashore Visitor's Center before reaching Provincetown, located at the very tip of the Cape. Enjoy time browsing shops, galleries, and restaurants in this vibrant artists' village. In the afternoon, you'll have a choice of experiences: head out to sea on a whale-watching excursion to spot majestic marine life in its natural habitat or stay on shore for a unique dune tour through the protected sands of the National Seashore. A delicious, included dinner caps off the day. (B, D)

Day 3: After breakfast, set sail aboard the morning ferry to the charming island of Martha's Vineyard. Upon arrival, you'll enjoy a scenic tour highlighting the island's distinct towns, history, and coastal beauty. Spend free time exploring Edgartown, known for its historic whaling roots and lovely shops, and visit Oak Bluffs to stroll among its colorful gingerbread cottages. Return to the mainland in the late afternoon and enjoy another dinner included this evening. (B, D)

Day 4: Following breakfast, travel to Plymouth, America's Hometown. Take in photo stops at Plymouth Rock, the Forefathers Monument, and the Mayflower II. Then, enjoy lunch on your own along the waterfront before embarking on a hands-on lobstering eco-tour, where you'll learn about local marine life and sustainable fishing practices. Back on the Cape, enjoy a guided tour of Hyannis, including sights like the John F. Kennedy Memorial and Hyannisport. This evening, celebrate your final night with a traditional lobster dinner at Tugboats overlooking the marina (alternate entrées available). (B, D)

Day 5: After your final breakfast, it's time to say goodbye to the Cape. Depart for home with a heart full of memories, seashells in your pocket, and the spirit of the seaside still with you. (B)
